

ICAJ 4 Weeks Certificate Course in Forensic Accounting

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

This course is being offered in response to overwhelming requests from participants at previous 1-day Forensic Accounting workshops, for the training to be expanded and to include case studies and simulation exercises to support the material taught.

The course in Forensic Accounting was designed to help local accounting and audit professionals to improve their competence in the application of 'cutting-edge' forensic accounting methods. Overall, participants are expected to develop the core knowledge and skills needed to identify and detect fraud while being able to perform forensic accounting/auditing assignments.

The course will be delivered over a 4 week period commencing July 6. The course will be presented by **noted Forensic Accountant, Collin Greenland** and participants will receive a **certificate of participation as well as verifiable CPD credits for attending.**

PREREQUISITES:

Forensic accounting has long been regarded worldwide as one of the ‘20 hot job tracks of the future’ and job opportunities abound in both the private and public sectors, across many industries. Jamaica spent in excess of half a billion dollars on fees for forensic audits probing the finance of banks and insurance companies after the financial sector meltdown in the mid 1990s. On a global level, by 2010, the demand for forensic accounting services was even further confirmed when the World Statistics showed that fee income earned from Forensic Audit exceeded two billion US dollars.
